CCC Countryside Access,

Please accept my objection to the above Order on the following grounds:

1. Insufficient case has been made by the rail operating authority for the closure of this long established crossing.
2. That in the making of this order there has been no independent assessment conducted to evaluate the risks associated with the displacement of the public onto the adjacent public highway and public car-parking areas by the proposed path diversion.
3. That the diversion is creating a public footpath on land over which the public has almost certainly already established bridleway rights arising from pedal-cycle use.
4. That the ownership of the land over which the path is proposed to be diverted, and the consequent right to dedicate the way, has not been conclusively established.
5. That arrangements allegedly made to determine the responsibility for the maintenance of the path surface and all associated over-bridges and supporting structures and underpasses are not sufficiently explicit or detailed.
