They need funding to purchase an AED defibrillator device to enhance their first aid and safety provision, and a gas blending stick capable of providing enhanced oxygen mix which the club has a requirement to provide.</p> <p>Carlisle Sub Aqua Club encourages all its members to be 'dive fit'. In addition, the physical exertion required to undertake diving activities, is purported to 'burn' around 600 calories per hour.
