# Scrutiny Management Board Briefing from Chair of Adults Scrutiny Board

### 1.0 Purpose of Update

- 1.1 This report updates Scrutiny Management Board (SMB) on the work of the Adults Scrutiny Advisory Board and any issues and developments that have occurred since the last meeting of SMB.

### 2.0 Board Meeting Update

- 2.1 Since the last meeting of the Scrutiny Management Board the Adult Scrutiny Advisory Board held an informal session on the 20<sup>th</sup> July. It received information on and considered:

- The impact of COVID 19 on the Residential Care Sector in Cumbria
- The secondary consequences of COVID 19
- Adult Social Care impact of COVID-19 - with a specific focus on Safeguarding Adult
- The future Work Programme for the Board in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic and its impacts

- 2.2 The next meeting of the Adults Scrutiny Board will take place on the 16<sup>th</sup> October. It will be looking at:

- Changes to Discharge Arrangements and impact on Delayed Transfers of Care
- Adult Social Care Reshaping
- The All Ages Carers Charter
- Cumbria Care – Future Developments

### 3.0 Additional Scrutiny activity undertaken by the Board

- 3.1 Cumbria Health Scrutiny Committee and Adults' Scrutiny Advisory Board are having a series of joint meetings to look at areas covering the closer integration of Health and Care Services. These will be re-established in the Autumn with an initial focus on the Health and Care recovery plans.

### 4.0 Conclusion

- 4.1 The Board will continue to focus on developments in the People Directorate. The new Executive Director has established a positive working relationship with the Board.
