

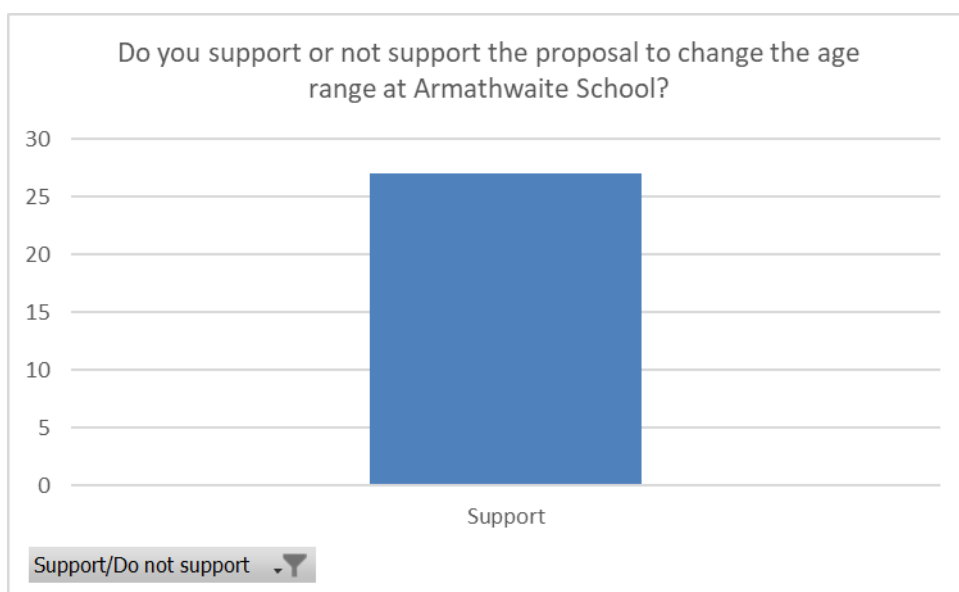
Consultation on a change of age range at Armathwaite School

Introduction

Between 7 September and 2 October 2020 the county council carried out a consultation seeking the views of parents, staff, stakeholders and the local community over the potential change of age range at Armathwaite School. The existing age range of the school is 4 to 11 and the proposal is to change that to 3 to 11 years of age.

Summary of responses

A total of 27 responses were received during the consultation period all supporting the proposal. A number of supportive emails were also sent to the school.
