STATEMENT OF REASONS

Cumbria County Council considers it is expedient to introduce restrictions on Duke Street Barrow-in-Furness for the following reasons set out in Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, namely:-

(c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), and

(f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

- Introduction No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions
Proposed adjacent to new trees to prevent parking where it is unsuitable
- Time Limited Waiting parking place Mon – Sat 8am – 6pm 1 hour no return within 2 hours
The existing lengths of restriction are proposed to be amended to retain 10 spaces for parking on Duke Street whilst improving the amenity of the street.
- Disabled Badge Holder Only Parking Places
It is proposed that the existing length equating to three parking spaces be amended to spread the provision across the length of Duke Street between Ramsden Square and Town Square. This provides increased accessibility to space whilst maintaining the level of spaces provided for Disabled Badge Holders only.
