

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, CARLISLE URBAN AND RURAL
AREA)(CONSOLIDATION AND MINOR AMENDMENT OF
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2001) VARIATION (NO. 56) ORDER 20<>

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the proposed Order will be to: -
 - (a) Introduce “No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions on parts of Eden Park Crescent, Victoria Road, Lancaster Street, Thornton Road, Etterby Road, Currock Road, and Petteril Street (access lane), Carlisle.
 - (b) Introduce “No Waiting, 8 am – 6 pm, Monday to Friday” restrictions on parts of Broad Street (rear lane), Petteril Street (rear lane), and River Street (rear lane), Carlisle;
 - (c) Extend the “No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions on the south-east side of St Aidan’s Road, Carlisle, by removing the “Disc Parking Places – Residents of Zone B exempt, between the hours of 8 am – 8 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am – 6 pm Saturday”;
 - (d) Extend the “No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions on the north-west side of Marconi Road by some 37 metres in a southerly direction.
 - (e) Introducing “No Stopping, Monday – Friday, between 8.30 am – 9.30 am and between 2.30 pm and 4.00 pm on School Keep-Clear markings”, on the west side of Langrigg Road, Mortonrigg.
3. Full details of the proposed Order, together with a plan showing the length of road concerned, and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned during normal working hours.
