1.Resident	Petteril Street	Resident is pleased that CCC are considering implementing parking restrictions to aid with inconsiderate parking. However the resident has pointed out that the parking issues run along the side of the play area and not private garage. Suggest that the access lanes to be DYL and also DYL the highway around the play area. White bar markings to highlight private garage accesses. Suggest we carry out a review of parking restrictions within the area and limit the amount of Resident Permits issued.	Parking review for Zone B is scheduled for 2020/2021. White bar markings are only advisory so may not resolve the parking issues experienced by private garage users. Photos provided showing parked cars next to play area causing obstruction.	RECOMMENDATION –  Abandon the proposal in its entirety (and uphold any objections which have been received).
2.Resident	Petteril Street	Request for the highway surrounding the play area to be NWAAT to prevent inconsiderate parking.	Majority of the Formal Consultation correspondence indicates that the surrounding highway of the play area to have NWAAT restrictions implemented.	RECOMMENDATION –Abandon the proposal in its entirety (and uphold any objections which have been received).
3.Resident	Unknown	Concerns regarding this proposal having a negative effect for the residents. Limited On Street parking which causes issues for the residents on a daily basis. Feels the On Street parking is already over prescribed. Refuse vehicles have great difficulty accessing the rear lanes. Resident has also submitted a petition of objections to the SYL proposal.	Objection of its entirety. A list of 13 signatures against the proposal has been submitted.	RECOMMENDATION –Abandon the proposal in its entirety (and uphold any objections which have been received).

4.Relation of River Street occupier	Brampton	Objection of its entirety, residents suffer enough with limited parking without the County Council added to the existing parking problem within the area. Resident has disabilities and an additional parking restrictions will have a big impact on their mobility.	Objection of its entirety.	RECOMMENDATION – Abandon the proposal in its entirety (and uphold any objections which have been received).
5.Resident	River Street	In support of NWAAT restrictions be implemented to the rear lane accesses. Objections to the rest of proposal due to the surrounding streets already experiencing parking issues without the County Council added further restrictions to the rear lanes. On match days the residents park long the play area due insufficient parking spaces.	Objects in part to the proposal. Supports the NWAAT proposal and objects to the rest. If vehicles park in the rear lane access is blocked.	RECOMMENDATION –Abandon the proposal in its entirety (and uphold any objections which have been received).
6.Resident	Petteril Street	The area around the play park offers an alternative place to park when the rest of the street is busy. The bin lorries do have problems accessing the play areas when residents park on the bends.	Objection of restrictions around play park. In favour of placing double yellow lines on the access lanes to help bin collection and emergency vehicles.	RECOMMENDATION –Abandon the proposal in its entirety (and uphold any objections which have been received).
