

Scrutiny Management Board Briefing from Chair of Adults Scrutiny Board

1.0 Purpose of Update

- 1.1 This report updates Scrutiny Management Board (SMB) on the work of the Adults Scrutiny Advisory Board and any issues and developments that have occurred since the last meeting of SMB.

2.0 Board Meeting Update

- 2.1 Since the last meeting of the Scrutiny Management Board the Adult Scrutiny Advisory Board met on 4th October and considered:

- Delayed Transfers of Care;
- The development of Reasonable Offer for Adult Social Care in Cumbria Shared Lives;
- The Learning Disability & Autism Board Action Plan; and,
- Safeguarding Adults at risk from abuse and neglect

- 2.2 The next meeting of the Adults Scrutiny Advisory Board will take place on the 16th January 2020 and Members will consider:

- The new Adult Social Care staffing structure;
- Furness Drugs Deaths;
- The All Ages Carers Charter; and,
- Safeguarding Adults at risk from abuse and neglect.

3.0 Additional Scrutiny activity undertaken by the Board

- 3.1 Cumbria Health Scrutiny Committee and Adults' Scrutiny Advisory Board are having a series of joint meetings to look at areas covering the closer integration of Health and Care Services:

- the Joint Advisory Group met on 22nd October and focused on Adverse Childhood Experiences and how they impact in later life. It made a number of recommendations to both System Leadership Boards;
- the next meeting of the Joint Health and Adults Advisory group will be considering the county's Dementia profile.

- 3.2 The Chair and Vice Chair of the Board have met with the Assistant Director - Provider Services regarding future developments within Cumbria Care.

4.0 Conclusion

- 4.1 The Board will continue to focus on developments in relation to adults, particularly providing input into the development of emerging policies and new ways of working.
