

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, PENRITH) (CONSOLIDATION AND
PROVISION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) ORDER 20<>

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the proposed Order will be to: -

Consolidate the provisions of the following Orders into one concise Order: -

The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Penrith) (Consolidation and Provision of Traffic Regulations) Order 2017;

The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Penrith) (Consolidation and Provision of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2017) Variation (No. 1) Order 2018; and

The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Penrith) (Consolidation and Provision of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2017) Variation (No. 2) Order 2018;

AND

- (i) Replace the existing "Parking for Disabled Badge Holders and Permit Holders I only, At Any Time" parking place on the north-west side of Harrison Street with "No Waiting At Any Time" restrictions;
- (ii) Reduce the existing "No Waiting At Any Time" restriction on the north side of Foster Street by 6m and extend existing parking bay with a 'Parking for Disabled Badge Holders and Permit Holders I only, At Any Time' restriction by the same distance in a northwesterly direction;
- (iii) Reduce existing 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm' restriction by approx 6m and extend existing parking bay with a 'Parking for Disabled Badge Holders and Permit Holders I only, At Any Time' restriction by the same distance in a northwesterly direction;
- (iv) Introduce "One-Way" traffic restrictions on: -
 - (a) Harrison Street;
 - (b) Askam Crescent from its junction with Brentfield Way to its junction with Friars Rise (south-westerly direction);
 - (c) The entire length of Friargate car park access road (northerly direction);
- (v) Introduce "No Waiting At Any Time" restrictions on part of Sand Croft;
- (vi) Introduce "Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight, Except for Access) restriction on the entire length of Gillan Way.

3. Full details of the proposed Order together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and copies of the Orders to be consolidated and revoked, may be inspected at the offices of Cumbria Highways, Skirsgill Depot, Skirsgill, Penrith and the offices of the undersigned during normal working hours.
