## APPLICATION REPORT

### Application Summary

Project Start Date: Pending confirmation of sufficient funding.

Eden Runners is a constituted community running club, serving Penrith and the Eden District. The junior runners includes 86 members aged between 8-18 years old. The club provide running and coaching training opportunities several times per week, with clear physical and mental health benefits.

Through September to March between 6-8pm the junior runners train on the streets around Penrith. It is vital for the runners to be visible and safe and so the club would like to purchase a stock of florescent and waterproof hi-vis tops that will be loaned to all runners who attend training sessions and don't have adequate sports wear. The junior members also train for cross country events during the winter months and suitable footwear is essential to reduce accidents and injury. To ensure all junior runners are well equipped for training and events, they would also like to procure and purchase 25 pairs of spikes that will be loaned out to junior members who do not have adequate kit for training and events.
