VARIATION (NO. 1) ORDER 20><

Statement of Reasons

Following previous studies carried out to investigate the impact of the Eden Local Plan on traffic flows in and around Penrith the County Council proposes alterations to parking restrictions on Portland Place and traffic and parking restrictions on Inglewood Road

Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to make the above order for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

Portland Place, Penrith; Proposed removal of 1hr Disc parking bay and introduction of new No Waiting at Any Time restriction

On the north side of Portland Place for the following reason:-

- c) For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Inglewood Road, Penrith; Proposed introduction of No Waiting at Any Time restriction

On the northwest side of Inglewood Rd from its junction with Salkeld Road in a southerly direction for the following reason:-

- c) For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Inglewood Road, Penrith; Proposed Prohibition of Driving.

At the junction of Inglewood Road and Scotland Road for the following reason:-

- a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
