The minutes from the Highway Sub-Group should contain specific recommendations to the Barrow Local Committee.

Terms of Reference

The Highways Advisory Sub-Group will make recommendations on any of the following to the Highway Authority namely the Barrow Local Committee:

- The Local Transport Plan
- The Cumbria Highway Programmes
- The Local Highway Programmes both Capital and Revenue
- The Annual Package of Measures
- Road Traffic Regulation Orders
- Priority Safety Schemes
- Road Traffic Safety Schemes
- Highway Improvement Schemes
- Highway/Footway Extinguishments
- Emergency Item/s to contact the Highway Network Manager Immediately
- Anything not relating or relevant to the Advisory Sub-Group Report will not be discussed but is to be brought to the attention of the Highway Network Manager or Team when the Advisory Sub-Group ends
- If a Member raises an issue, e.g. residents parking etc. they will be informed to firstly to survey the residents and then present evidence the levels of support before formal discussions take place

The Highway Sub-Group will monitor the Highway Programmes and the associated Highways Budgets.

The Highway Sub-Group will establish task and finish working parties for (Scheme Specific) (Residents Parking) (Disabled Parking) Etc
