(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)
(WINDERMERE) VARIATION ORDER ><

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to make the above Order for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 : -

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or,
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

The proposals, as shown on the plans, are as follows: -

Craig Walk, Windermere

Concerns have been raised regarding parking causing an obstruction at the junction Lake Road and for the first 60 metres of Craig Walk. This road is currently un-restricted and can become congested with parked vehicles. This can make it difficult for residents as well as refuse vehicles and emergency services to pass through.

No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) restrictions are proposed for the first 60 metres of Craig Walk from its junction with Lake Road.

Brook Road, Windermere

Concerns have been raised regarding parking causing obstruction at the junctions of Brook Road with Lake Road and New Road. These junctions are currently un-restricted and can become congested with parked vehicles. Parked vehicles can make it difficult for all vehicles including residents as well as refuse vehicles and emergency services to pass through.

No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) restrictions are proposed at both junctions of Brook Road.

St Marys Park and Church Street, Windermere

Concerns have been raised regarding parking causing obstruction on sections at the entrance of St Mary's Park and Church Street. At St Mary's Park this can make it difficult for residents as well as refuse vehicles and emergency services to pass through. At Church Street parking outside the church can become problematic causing parking issues on the A591. No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines) and waiting limited bays are proposed to assist traffic flow.

New Road, Windermere

Concerns have been raised regarding parking causing obstruction along New Road. Sections of this road can become congested with parking and cause visibility issues for vehicles leaving the private properties, hotels and business along New Road.

It is proposed to extend the No Waiting 9am-7pm that is currently on part of New Road in a southerly direction onto Lake Road up to its junction with Beresford Road.
