

**The County of Cumbria (Various Roads Eden Area)
(Appleby Horse Fair) (Consolidation and Provision Traffic Regulations) Order
20><**

Statement of Reasons

Location: U3337 Church Bank, Appleby

Proposed Restriction: Prohibition of the passage of Motor Vehicles, Horse Drawn Vehicles and Ridden or Accompanied Horses (Except for Access), between the hours of 1000 – 1800 each of the four days the Fair is in place

Following a request for the introduction of additional restrictions being made by the Appleby New Fair Multi-Agency Strategic Co-ordination Group (MASCG), in order to formalise a long standing arrangement that Boroughgate and the part of Appleby located to the west of the River Eden be kept free of equine traffic during the Fair, Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to introduce the above restriction for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: -

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (d) for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.

Location: B6542 The Sands, Appleby

Proposed Restriction: Prohibition of the passage of Horse Drawn Vehicles and Ridden or Accompanied Horses, between the hours of 1000 – 1800 each of the four days the Fair is in place

Following a request for the introduction of additional restrictions being made by the Appleby New Fair Multi-Agency Strategic Co-ordination Group (MASCG) and following the measures being successfully trailed in 2019 Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to introduce the above restriction for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: -

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (d) for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.

Location: B6260 Bridge Street, Appleby

Proposed Restriction: Prohibition of the passage of Motor Vehicles, Horse Drawn Vehicles and Ridden or Accompanied Horses (Except for Access), between the hours of 1000 – 1800 each of the four days the Fair is in place

Location: A685 Appleby Road to Brough

Proposed Restriction: 40mph Speed Limit

Following a request for the introduction of additional restrictions being made by the Appleby New Fair Multi-Agency Strategic Co-ordination Group (MASCG), because of the likelihood of danger to the public and to allow the safe management of the Appleby New Fair and Police Patrols on the run up, during and following the Fair. Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose introduce the above restriction for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
