APPLICATION REPORT

Application Summary

Eden Rural Foyer in Penrith is a community resource to support young people and the wider community. They provide access to training, learning and enhanced social opportunities.

Staff at Eden Rural Foyer have developed a youth club project which will aim to commence in September 2022 for young people aged between 11 - 19 living in Penrith and the surrounding area. The youth provision sessions will be delivered by staff at the foyer and will include activities lead by the young people. To help promote the youth provision, staff at the foyer will also be visiting local secondary schools to raise awareness about the club activities.

Eden Rural Foyer are applying for an initial amount of £4000 from the Penrith Youth Provision Fund allocation to cover the cost of staffing to run the session over a year.
