

## **Experimental Traffic Regulation Order - 24hr Rural Clearway and supported no verge parking, Howtown Road, Pooley Bridge**

### **Statement of Reasons**

Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to make the above Experimental Order for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: -

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the roads or any other roads of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run.

The Howtown Road is a narrow section of carriageway which is the access road to a number of camping/caravan sites which see large vehicles arriving. At times due to inconsiderate parking visitors to the sites have experienced difficulties accessing them. There are also concerns that emergency vehicles do not have clear widths to access the full extent of the road.
