

<b>ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION BY FUTURE ADULTS SCRUTINY ARRANGEMENTS</b>	
<b>Issue</b>	<b>Description</b>
Adults Social Care Position,	Adults Scrutiny Committees should receive regular reports possibly as a standing item outlining the current priorities and pressures within the Adult Social Care service in the authority area.
Quality Assurance Within Provider Services	Committees should receive updates and assurance into the overall governance held within Provider Services. Description of the audit process within Provider Services.
Workforce	Committees should closely monitor the actions being put in place to improve the Recruitment and Retention of Social Care staff.
Discharge Arrangements	Committees to have regular opportunities to scrutinise actions undertaken to support system flow improvements on changes to discharge arrangements and the impact on delayed transfers of care.
Shared Outcome Frameworks	The Integration White Paper sets out the government's approach to designing shared outcomes which will place person-centred care at the centre of their plans for reform, Implementation of shared outcomes will begin from April 2023.
CQC Assurance	Members are asked to consider any ongoing updates they would require on preparation for the future CQC inspections.
Carers	Members should receive details on the support provided to Carers where possible taking evidence directly from Carers and the groups which represent them.
Safeguarding Adults at risk from abuse and neglect	It is strongly recommended that Safeguarding is a Standing Item for each Committee meeting.

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
